



Joining a Google Meet

Parents can join Google Meet invitations via a computer or by phone. To join by computer, you will have the option of using video with computer audio or using computer video with a phone call for audio.


Your Google Meet invitation will contain a link for joining by computer as well as phone numbers and PIN code to enter if you choose to join by phone. You do not have to have a Google email account to join a Meet.



If you join by computer and are not using a Google email account, you will be prompted for your name, as shown here. If you are using a Google email address your name will be inserted.



If the teacher has not yet arrived, you will see this message until they do.



If you call by phone and the teacher has not yet joined, you will hear this message:

You have joined the call, but you are the only one here.

Every seven seconds a chime will play to let you know you are still connected. The message will repeat once every minute until the Meet organizer joins.
